How to Make a Custom Shape QR Code

1

Pick a shape

Choose a heart, circle, star, house, triangle, maple leaf, and more — or open the custom generator to browse dozens. Chunky shapes like circles and houses scan the most reliably.

2

Set your color

Pick a solid color or a two-color gradient. Keep the dots dark on a light background so the shape still scans cleanly.

3

Add your link

Paste the URL the code should open. The preview updates as you go.

4

Download and test

Download as PNG, JPG, or SVG — SVG for print so it stays sharp at any size. Scan-test on an iPhone and an Android, and give thin or spiky shapes a little extra size before printing.
