How to Make a Bing Maps QR Code

1

Choose what the code should do

Pick an action: drop a pin on an address or place, search a keyword like "coffee", or display a map centered on coordinates.

2

Fill in the details

Enter the address, keyword, or "latitude, longitude" as the center point, then choose a zoom level and map view — road, aerial, aerial with labels, or bird's eye. You can also paste an existing Bing Maps share link.

3

Download the QR code

Download as PNG, JPG, or SVG. SVG stays crisp at any print size. The map link is encoded into the pattern, so it never expires.

4

Test on iOS and Android

The code opens a normal Bing Maps web link, so any phone camera works. Scan it to confirm the right view opens before printing.
