How to Make a QR Code for Your Bar

1

Host your drink menu at a link

Your tap list, cocktail menu, or tasting notes on a web page, Google Doc, or hosted PDF.

2

Create a dynamic QR code in EZQR

Dynamic so you can update the tap list the moment a keg blows — the printed code stays the same.

3

Put it on tables, the bar, and the door

Table tents, the taproom door, flight paddles, with a caption like 'Scan for tonight's taps.'

4

Test on both phones

Scan from where guests sit, on an iPhone and an Android, before setting the codes out.

5

Update the menu anytime

Change prices, specials, or the live-music lineup from your dashboard — same printed code, current list. For shows, point guests to your ticketing page; the code isn't the ticket.
