How to Make a QR Code for Your Business

1

Pick where the code should send customers

Your website, booking page, Google reviews, menu, or a digital business card — wherever a scan should land.

2

Create your QR code in EZQR

A static code is free forever for a single fixed link. Create a dynamic code when you want to change the destination later and see scan counts by time, country, and device.

3

Add it to your print and signage

Business cards, packaging, storefront windows, receipts, flyers — anywhere a phone camera can reach, with a short caption telling people what they'll get.

4

Test before you print the run

Scan the proof on both an iPhone and an Android before committing to a full print run.

5

Repoint and track over time

With a dynamic code, update the destination from your dashboard as offers change — same printed code — and watch which placements actually get scanned.
