How to Make a QR Code for Your Small Business

1

Choose what one code should do

Send people to your Google reviews, menu or price list, socials, or contact details — one code on the window or counter.

2

Create the code in EZQR

Static codes are free forever for a single link. Go dynamic to change where the code points and see scan counts without reprinting.

3

Put it where customers already look

A window decal that works after hours, a counter card asking for a review, a table sign with your menu. Keep clear space around the code.

4

Scan-test on both phones

Scan from where customers will actually stand, on an iPhone and an Android, before printing.

5

Update it as things change

New menu, new promo, new hours? Repoint a dynamic code from your dashboard and the same printed sign shows the update.
