How to Make a QR Code for Your Wedding

1

Pick what guests should open

Your wedding website and RSVP form, a shared photo album, guest info like venue and schedule, or your gift registry.

2

Create the code in EZQR

Create a dynamic code so one code can point to the RSVP before the day and the photo album after it — no reprinting your stationery.

3

Add it to invitations and signage

Save-the-dates, invitation inserts, welcome signs, and table cards. A heart-shaped code is a nice touch on the invitation.

4

Test it before you print

Scan on an iPhone and an Android and walk through the RSVP so you know it works before the batch goes out.

5

Repoint it after the wedding

Switch a dynamic code from RSVP to your shared photo album so guests who scan later land on the pictures.
